



How a Dream Vacations Franchise Compares to Other Industries

Not all franchise opportunities are built the same. Startup costs, real estate needs, inventory demands, and staffing requirements vary dramatically by industry — and those differences shape the lifestyle of the Franchise Owner just as much as the bottom line. The chart below compares a Dream Vacations travel franchise against franchise opportunities in four other common industries.
